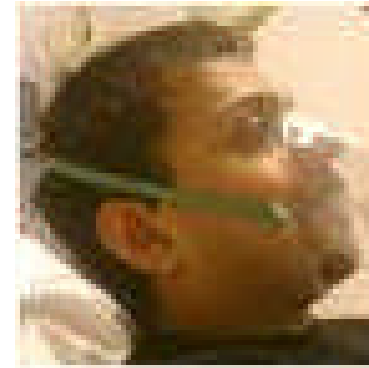

Asthma - the cost



Asthma costs the NHS around £889 million per year



~~Working~~ days

Over 12.7 million working days are lost to asthma each year

Caring for people who experience an asthma attack costs 3.5 times more than for those whose asthma is well controlled

Hospitalisation among children and adults



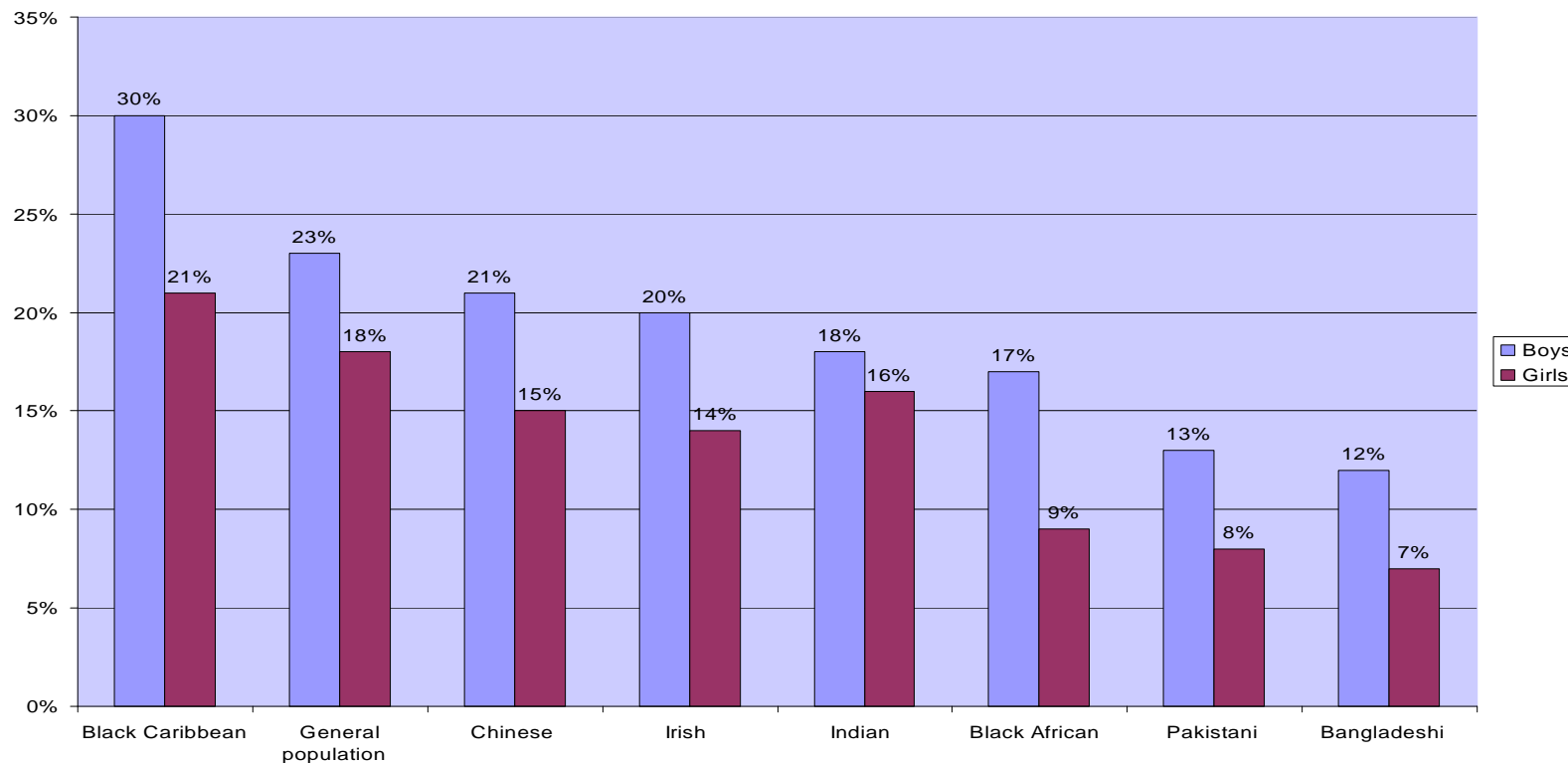
Compared to the white population,

Asthma in Boys and Girls (0-15)



Black Caribbean boys and girls were more likely than boys and girls in the general population to have had asthma diagnosed by a doctor

Asthma Information in 25 languages

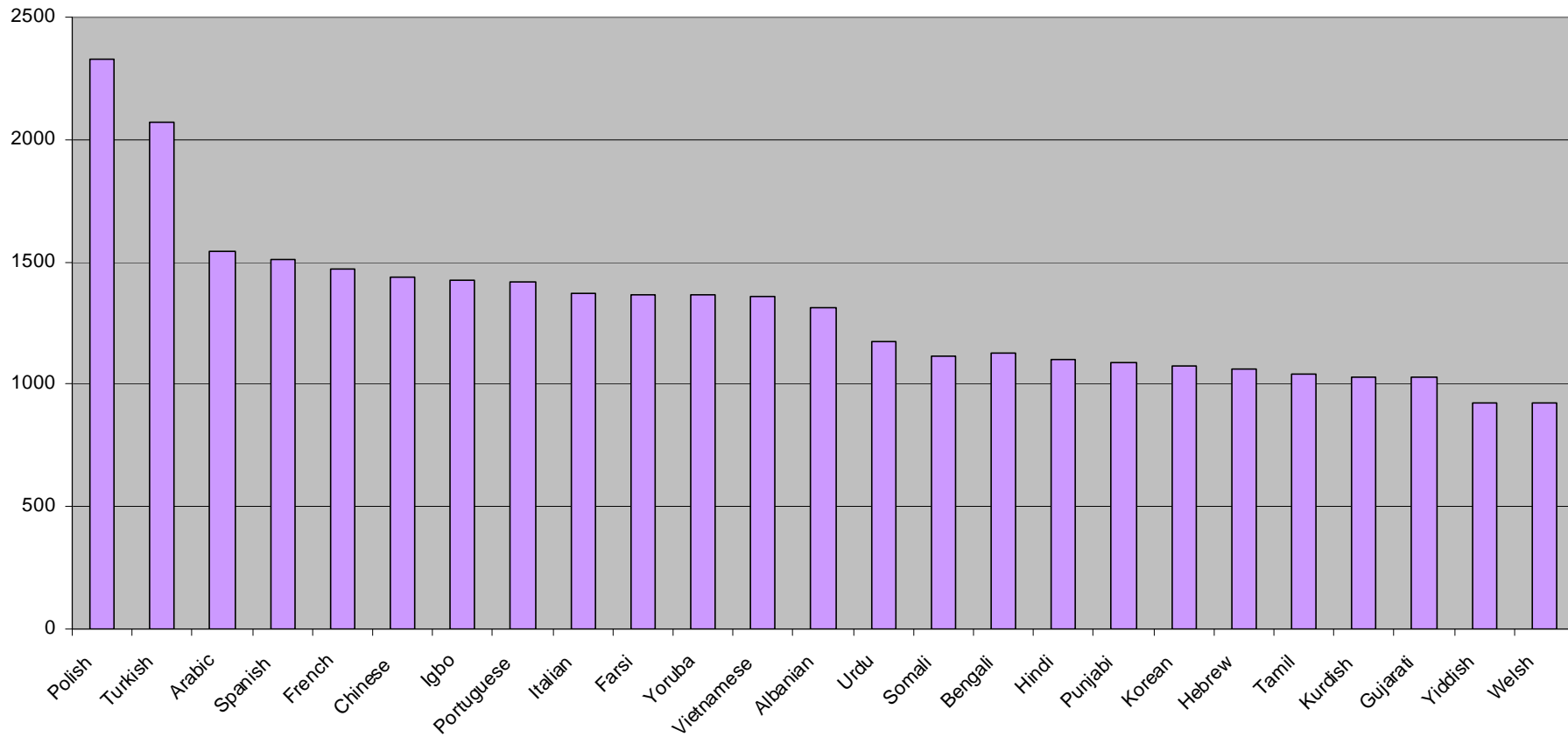


- Launched in Nov 2004 with 16 languages: Arabic, Bengali, Chinese, French, Gujarati, Hindi, Italian, Kurdish, Polish, Portuguese, Punjabi, Somali, Spanish, Turkish, Urdu, Welsh
- Tamil added Mar 2005
- Korean added July 2005
- Hebrew, Igbo, Vietnamese, Yiddish, Yoruba added Nov 2005
- Albanian, Farsi added July 2006
- Over 58018 downloads in total

Popularity of Languages



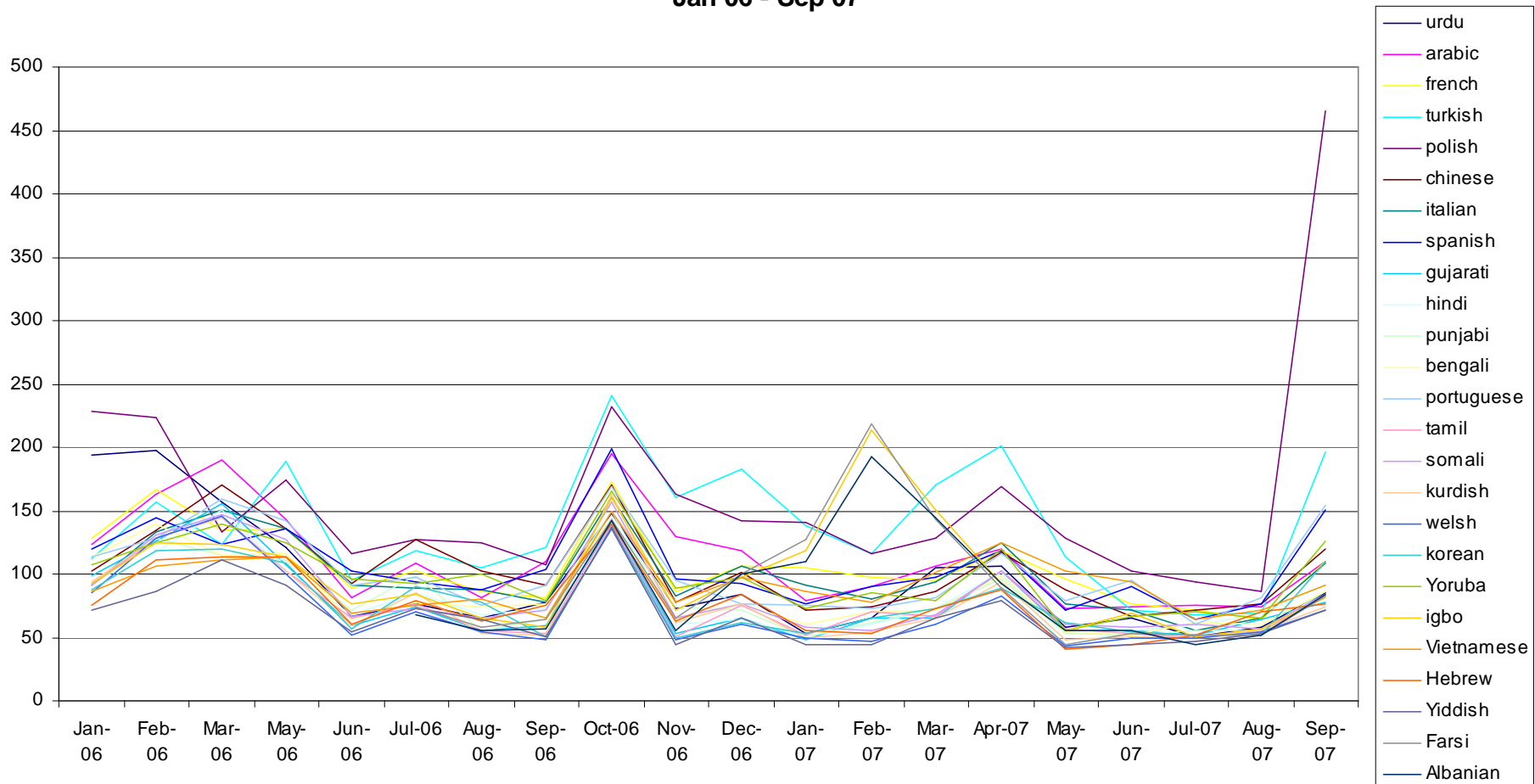
